# Special Meeting Called November 7th 2024

Club president Tim Lovett called a special club meeting for November 7th 2024 to address a serious incident that occurred at the club flying facility on Thursday evening October 24th 2024. Notification of the impending special meeting was sent out (emailed) to club membership seven days prior to the special meeting. The special meeting notification email included the date of the special meeting (November 7th 2024), Place and time of the special meeting (Massy McDonalds 769 Airport Freeway Hurst, TX 76053 at 7:00 PM).

#### Agenda:

1. **Discussion Topic:** The discussion topic for the special November 7th 2024 club meeting was to discuss the possible removal of a Greater Southwest Aero Modelers club member for rules violations of GSWAM club by-laws. (Continued P-2)

#### **About GSWAM**

The Greater Southwest Aero Modelers radio control flying club is a nonprofit organization. Membership is nondiscriminatory and open to anyone who agrees to abide by club rules. A condition of membership for insurance purposes is current affiliation with the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA). The club flying field is located on the north side of Randol Mill Road, 0.4 miles east of Highway 820 at 6903 Randol Mill Rd. Visitors are welcome whenever the gate is unlocked. Regular club meetings are held on the second Tuesday of each month at the McDonald's restaurant at Precinct Line #25720 769 Airport Fwy at 7:30 PM.

2. Attending club members first heard both sides of the incident then there was an in-depth discussion by club members regarding the incident to help determine if there are valid reasons for the member in question be removed from the Greater Southwest Aero Modelers club. After the discussion phase there will be a vote cast by club members to choose either to remove the club member for a period of one year or vote to **not** remove the club member from the Greater Southwest Aero Modelers club as per the GSWAM By-Laws Article III Section H Expulsion.

**Notice:** Meeting attendees who cast their vote were all GSWAM club members in good standing. A member in good standing has a current (2024) GSWAM club membership card and a current AMA card. Members who wished to vote were first asked to have their 2024 club membership card and their current AMA card present with them at the November 7th special meeting. Members who forgot their club membership cards and/or current AMA card were verified using the 2024 club membership roster. Tim Lovett was listed as the contact person in the notification email for those who had any questions prior to the coming special meeting.

Parties on both sides of the incident were allotted time to describe their view of what happened at the flying facility on the evening of October 24th 2024 to the attending club members. Many questions were asked and answered by individuals at the "Special Meeting". Information gained from the questions was used by club members to determine, as much as possible, what indeed happened the evening of October 24th.

#### Results:

GSWAM club member Dave Horton stood accused by Sky Elements employee (and GSWAM club member) Cameron Ellis of using his motor vehicle in a dangerous manner by attempting to block the Sky Elements employee (Cameron) from setting up for a drone practice session when the incident occurred. Both Cameron Ellis and Dave Horton were current members in good standing of the Greater Southwest Aero Modelers club at the time of the incident.

Dave explained he was not using his motor vehicle to intimidate, cause personal injury, or damage Cameron's (Sky Element's) drone equipment. Dave stated he was trying to position his vehicle in such a way as to prevent the Sky Elements employee from setting up at the location south of the control line area east of the big dirt hill. Dave did not know at the time Sky Elements had been given permission by club president Tim Lovett to practice at that location.

Cameron Ellis stated he was actually bumped by Dave's vehicle at which time he then removed the antenna from Daves vehicle. Cameron also stated he threw the antenna on the ground after removing it from Dave's vehicle. Dave then got out of his vehicle and picked up the broken antenna from the ground and moved towards Cameron in what he (Cameron) considered to be in a provocative manner holding the broken antenna.

Some verbal expletives were then exchanged back and forth and after a short period of time Dave left the flying facility. No one was injured and no property was damaged during the incident except for Dave's antenna.

After hearing both sides of the incident the issue came to a vote, and the results were the GSWAM club voted 30 votes to remove and 10 to retain. The end result was Dave was voted out of the club by the attending club members for a period of one year beginning November 7th 2024. There were 45 GSWAM club members in attendance at the special meeting and there were five club members who abstained from the voting process.

### Have you ever wondered how our runway Magically stays in such great shape?







## **GSW Club Flying Field Current Weather Status**


Weather station reports current temperature, winds/gusts, barometric pressure, precipitation rate, and dew point. Live weather info from the flying field.
