Meeting Called to Order: Tuesday August 12th, 2025 at 7:30 PM by club president Tim Lovett.

Members In Attendance: 17

Business Meeting Minutes Approval: The July 2025 Business Meeting Minutes posted in the July GSWAM newsletter were approved as written by a majority show of hands vote by attending club members.

Presidents Report: Tim reported the flying facilities perimeter area will be mowed by brush hog contractor Doug Haas. The bid to brush hog the perimeter area grass overgrowth was \$750.00, which is the same price as the previous perimeter area mowing bid. Doug is scheduled to mow the perimeter areas Friday August 15th at which time the field will be closed from 8:00 AM until 4:00 PM. An email blast to club members will be sent out notifying club members of the temporary field closing on Friday. Tim reported the coming Lawrence Harville Scale Masters Qualifier polo shirts are now on sale for \$25 each. Be sure to get your shirt ordered ASAP as they cannot be ordered at the event. Tim also reported the north end hog wire fencing had been repeatedly cut by unknown persons.

Field Report: Darrell Abby reported the flying field runway being in good shape. The runway irrigation system is now running two days a week and the mow crew is mowing twice a week. Electric fencing wires on the north end wooden walkway, (providing access from the parking lot to the shelter), is frayed and will soon fail if not repaired.

Treasurers Report: Club treasurer Michael Madar reported all GSWAM related bills were paid. Mike also reported concessions money had been stolen again.

Recessing The Flying Field Front Gate Back for Vehicle Safety: Dana Pierce reported he received three bid options:

- 1. New chain Link fencing material while reusing the old chain link gate. Estimated cost \$5,500
- 2. 8' cedar fencing material option \$4,700
- 3. Black powder coated fencing material \$4,600

Tim reported he planned on going to see if the city of Ft. Worth leasing representative might get a city crew out to assist in digging new fence and gate post holes. The gate post holes need to be dug at least 4' deep. The brush overgrowth will need to be removed on both sides of the gate prior to fencing contractors beginning work on moving the fence gate. The goal of moving the front gate back is to move the gate back 30' from the current gate location so when club members need to open the front gate their vehicle will be safely inside the fence perimeter and away from Randol Mill Road traffic. Those with longer vehicles will not have to park right next to Rando Mill Road while unlocking the front gate.



We have been discussing moving the gates back into the field about 30°. This will give us a safety margin when opening the field in the morning and locking up in the evening. At this point, if you have a large van, or are pulling a trailer, it is very close to Randol Mill Road. By moving the gates back, we can help protect our membership.

We also have a thief that is coming into the field late at night. He is coming through the gates as they do not close together tight enough to keep him from squeezing through. We are working on "helping him out". This is another area that the moving of the gates will help with security issues. We are working on it.

Field Report

August 20th 2025

The GSW flying field remains in fine condition for all aircraft types. The grass is turning a little brown since the rain has decreased but the sprinkler system is running overnight on Tuesday and Friday. Since the grass growth has slowed down, we still mow the runway twice a week but other areas are rotated and generally mowed once a week. The 'outfield' high grass has been mowed. That same contractor will return to transport/spread dirt in the north areas that are still very rough. Another future project is clearing the front gate area for the new entry configuration. All mowers are operational.

REPEAT: If you should mess up the hog fence for some reason, here's what <u>YOU</u> do: go to the storage bin in the cage and get a cardboard roll with a short length of 'hog wire' and a stake, if needed, and repair your boo-boo.

We anticipate excellent field conditions and cooler weather for the approaching event season (Sep and Oct). Come out and participate.
