Lawrence Harville Scale Masters Qualifier Report: Those of you who were at the qualifier event experienced a cool rainy beginning to the event, but soon the weather turned near perfect around 10 AM in the morning. The weather was nice for flying with light and variable winds and the competing pilots certainly took advantage of the situation posting above average flight scores. The event award plaques, made by Randy Mayhew, were a cut above previous award plaques with a photo of the pilot and an engraved metal inlay on the wooden plaque.

Front Gate Signage: There was a discussion regarding the flying facilities front gate signage. Club information that the general public needs to see is on the two gates themselves and when the front gates are open their attached signage cannot be seen easily from Randol Mill Rd.

Concession Cage Locked: Due to the repeated thievery of concession area drinks, snacks, and associated proceeds from purchases, a chain and lock have been installed to prevent the local park bandits from stealing items in the concession cage. If you are the last person to leave the flying field be sure the concessions gate is securely locked. The concessions lock combo is currently the same as the front gate combination.

Field Report: Feral hogs regularly pay the GSW flying facility nightly visits and recently the destructive hogs damaged a large area outside of the electric fence area. Paul Lange shared, with attending club members, the possibility of using solar powered electric fencing for outlying areas within the flying facility (control line and helicopter areas). Current battery and solar panel technologies enable current electric solar powered fences to operate up to two weeks without sunlight. Paul reported solar panel powered electric fencing costs beginning at around \$129.00. Further information regarding solar powered electric fencing will be gathered and reported at the November 2025 club meeting. Mark Foster reported the helicopter area's perimeter ground timbers, (that contains the gravel under the assembly tables), are to be moved closer to the heli area assembly tables to get more parking area space. Mark also reported he would be adding more gravel to the heli shelter area within the relocated ground timbers. Mark Foster is donating his time, labor, new timber, and gravel to the club. GSW Halloween Nite Flight Event: On November 1st the GSWAM club will host the "Halloween Nite Flight" event. There will be the usual night flying and later show a "G" rated movie friendly for any attending kids. Youngsters at the event are invited to wear their Halloween in their costumes as well.
