




## President's Report

Merry Christmas!!!! I hope this finds you and your family well and we hope all the best for you.

Things are moving right along. There has been some activity from the City of Fort Worth along Randol Mill Road to the east of our property. We have discovered that a re-routing of Randol Mill Road as part of a surface flooding project is starting. There have been trees cleared on the west side of the Mallard Cove housing addition along the new right of way. This project starts on the east side of the housing addition and comes west to the eastern corner of the flight field. The two culverts that run under Randol Mill Rd are to be re-worked to aid the water flow during rainstorms.

This has been the wrong week to find out about this project, but I am attempting to find out where the relocation of the traffic lanes are headed ultimately. I did manage to contact the project manager yesterday, who did not know the answers to my questions. I have received the phone number for another contact with the City, but he is out for the holiday. The manager I did speak with said that within five years Randol Mill Road will be 5 lanes wide in front of the airfield. But, he couldn't tell me if the roadway that is there now will be the south or the north side of the new road. Obviously if it is the south side, the City will be taking a good portion of our field north of the fenceline.

Your officers are working to gain information as quickly as we can. The movement of the front gates will be placed on hold until that information can be gathered. Bear with us, we will keep you posted and informed.


Coming up to the end of the year I have been looking over the field. The field maintenance crew has really got the field looking good. Make certain you thank those men often for the job they do.

## *Treasurers Report*


December... And if you are like me... you are walking around your resident grounds trying figure out just where you will store that newly bought, gifted or built "aviation vehicle".




